

# SAL SALIS + SAIL NINGALOO = SAIL & SNORKEL

Our 6 night / 7 day package combines 3 nights at Sal Salis with 3 nights aboard Shore Thing – the best way to discover where the Outback meets the Reef. At Sal Salis you can take part in guided walks through the Cape Range National Park, head out on an optional whale shark swim tour (mid-March to July) or a humpback whale swim tour (August to October), enjoy more Ningaloo Reef snorkelling & kayaking or just kick-back and read a book or relax in your hammock. The team on board Shore Thing will keep you busy with snorkelling, diving and kayaking in remote bays along the Coral Coast.

## ITINERARY

- **Day 1:** Arrival Learmonth Airport transfer to Sal Salis where you will join us for 3 nights in a Wilderness Tent, designed to blend with the dunes and low lying coastal scrub. The tents have comfortable beds and eco-friendly en-suite bathrooms with solar hot water showers.
- Days 2 & 3: Included are guided walks in the Cape Range National Park as well as snorkelling & kayak-snorkels along the Ningaloo Reef. There is the option to head out to sea on a whale shark swim (mid-March to July) or humpback whale swim (August to October) experience, at extra cost.
  Chef prepared Meals are shared in the Lodge, the social heart of camp where an open bar and lounge area provide a great spot for relaxation.
- **Day 4:** Farewell the team at Sal Salis and say hello to your pilot. It is a 45 minute scenic flight south along the Reef from Yardie Airstrip to Coral Bay Airstrip where the Sail Ningaloo crew will meet you and transfer you to the jetty to board Shore Thing for your next 3 nights. Shore Thing is a 51ft catamaran – a boat, not a cruise ship. The important things are provided, storage nooks, comfortable beds and air conditioning for hot nights. Beds can be made up as twin or double and there is a triple option suited only to parents and a small child.

- **Day 5 & 6:** Head for places such as Asho's Gap, The Stag Forest and Five Fingers Reef, perfect spots to explore reef lagoons either by kayak or in a mask, snorkel and fins. You might see turtles, manta rays, dugongs grazing on seagrass beds and inquisitive dolphins chasing fish throughout the clear water. Enjoy delicious meals prepared daily onboard and while away the hours out in the water or relaxing on the deck of Shore Thing.
- **Day 7:** Eventually the time comes to leave the Coral Coast and farewell Shore Things' skipper & crew where Sail Ningaloo will transfer you to Learmonth Airport in time for your afternoon departing flight.

### THE DETAILS

- The tour can operate in reverse and be extended.
- Dates will be planned to Sail Ningaloo's departures.
- A luggage limit of 15kgs per person will apply.
- Sail Ningaloo is inclusive of all meals & non-alcoholic beverages and activities\* (alcoholic drinks from the bar are available for purchase).
- Sal Salis is inclusive of all meals, drinks from a select open bar, guided activities and National Park guest fees.
- Whale shark or humpback whale swim experiences can be added at an additional cost, please ask our reservations team for details.


