

# **DRIVE DIRECTIONS**FROM EXMOUTH

## **BEFORE YOU LEAVE EXMOUTH**

Please call the camp on **08 99494173 BEFORE** you leave Exmouth to come to Sal Salis so we can be waiting to collect your luggage at the car park.

There is  ${\bf NO}$  mobile phone coverage when you leave the town of Exmouth.

# Arrival time is from 14.00 and departure time is before 11.00, unless by prior arrangement.

There is no lunch provided on arrival or departure days. There are several restaurants in Exmouth to stop and have a bite to eat - Bamboo, See Salt, Froth, Adrift Café, Pot-shot, The Bakery and Mantarays Ningaloo Resort.

If driving in the evenings or early morning we advise that you take it very slowly as there is an abundance of wildlife and collisions with them are all too common. There is a NO driving at night policy with accordance to National Park regulations.

Sal Salis is located at SOUTH MANDU beach

#### **IMPORTANT**

Please advise in advance if you are towing a caravan or trailer, as we need to advise National Parks if these vehicle types will be staying in the park overnight. Guests who self-drive to camp are asked to check their footwear on arrival at the South Mandu car park to ensure that they are not bringing any seeds into the camp and surrounding country. Please note that there is a 'no pet policy' at Sal Salis Ningaloo Reef. Guests should also note that feeding of wildlife is not permitted.

# **DIRECTIONS**

- Head North out of town towards the Tall Radio Towers (VLF Towers), Mildura wreck and Yardie Creek road
- You will be driving for approx. 15 min when you will reach a sign saying CAPE RANGE NATIONAL PARK, YARDIE CREEK RD please turn left.
- It is about 66km to South Mandu beach, there is no sign that says SAL SALIS on the road.
- You will pass the Lighthouse Caravan park as well at the Lighthouse itself and the road will turn south running parallel with the sea on your right and the range on your left.
- You will pass Yardie Homestead and Tantabiddi Boat ramp.
- Please stop at the Ranger's station and pay your vehicle entrance fee to the Park. We take care of your nightly/per person rate and pay that directly to National Parks. Even if there is no ranger please stop and pay (follow the directions on how to do this) as they do come and check the cars in the parking lot.
- Holiday and Annual Park Passes are available for purchase if you are planning on visiting multiple National Parks in WA (Discounts on these passes are also available to RAC Members).
- Keep heading south passing the Milyering Visitors Information Centre
- Further down you will pass Turquoise bay (South Mandu is exactly 5km past this turn off)
- Pass Oyster Stacks and North Mandu
- Turn right into **South Mandu** car park.
- If you pass Bloodwood Creek, you have gone too far.
- A staff member will meet you there if you have called in advance, if not please just take your valuables out of the car (leaving your luggage in the car) and follow the well-worn path in behind the dunes. It is about a 10 min / 900m walk to camp.
- You will then see the tents and a "SAL SALIS guests only" sign
  on your left. Please follow this path behind the tents all the way
  down to the lodge where we will be waiting for you.
